I have the honor to report.
That on the evening of the 25 Instant
I requested by official letter to His
Excellency Hamid Pasha, that if it
were consistent with regulations,
a salute of the Castle guns might
be fired the next day for celebration

Accordingly upon the 24th a Salute of Twenty One guns was fired, and the Castle flag kept flying all day.

The old fashioned Moslems were excessively angry at this innovation, and not the less so, for its having occurred during the month of Ramadan.

I have never known the anniversary to be celebrated with so much of good will, from officials

and deputations, and private persons, arriving at Her Majesty's Consulate, from early morning till night, as on that occasion.
