I have the honour to report that on the 21st instant two hundred and fifteen men of the 11th Battalion, 33rd Regiment, quartered at Jaffa were ordered to proceed to Jerusalem for the purpose of maintaining order during the prevalence of the Greek ecclesiastical dissensions.

Mr. Falanga reports that four hundred troops arrived yesterday at Jaffa from Beirut and were to leave for -
