Dear Mr. Brewster
I have the honor to acknowledge
the receipt of your Circular
dated 28th March mentioning to me a copy of
a "Confidential" Circular from Mr. Webster
to a Mr. Goodwin dated Albany 24th

I beg to say that up to the present
moment no thing has transpired here con-
cerning the intention of the British Govern-
ment sending Mr. Webster from Palestine
& Constantinople, and therefore I am not
able to report to you on this subject -

The party the Country remains in
the same unsettled and disorganized
state as I have described it to be in all the
despatches which I have written on this
subject since the British Occupation. And
it is now my opinion that without energy
and integrity the most wise and com-
prehensive measures would fail to
restore it to order and good government.
