I have the honour to inform
Your Excellency that Mgr. Serothos,
the new Greek Patriarch of Jerusalem,
arrived here a short time ago and has
accomplished all the civil and ecclesiastical
formalities attached to his installation,
the Turkish Authorities paying him high
honours on the occasion.

A satisfactory feature in the
proceedings is the reconciliation which has
taken place between the native Greek

It is credibly stated that the former
have been warmly urged to this step by
the Russian Consul; a further inducement
was doubtless the demand made by the
Government upon the Community, in
common with other non-Musulman
sects, for the payment of the Military
commutation tax, which, by a recent
decision of the Porte, was ordered to be
levied from the inhabitants of Jerusalem,
hitherto exempt therefrom, and for a
period of five years retroactively. It
is the custom for the different Convents
materially to assist their respective
co-religionists in the payment of such
taxes and contributions. For the Greek
Community their Convent will now pay

this tax, and Mgr. Jerotheos has invited
them to submit to him their demands
and grievances, to which he has promised
his best consideration with a view to meet
their wishes as far as possible.
