amongst the Jews, has been carried on for over 50 years, & has been much appreciated by them, as the statistics forwarded lately to His Ex. the Pasha show. Moreover, the Hospital holds an Imperial Iradi from His Imperial M. the Sultan.

This matter of espionage is becoming a very annoying & serious affair, & is sure to lead to grave consequences, if not put down soon with a firm hand. The unseemly riot that occurred last year in connection with the woman who died in the Hospital might well serve as a warning.

This week the wife of Mr. Metzger an employe of the Society, had her life endangered by not getting at once the medicine prescribed for her, for
serious

serious uterine hemorrhage, the delay having been caused by the Jewish patrol who actually detained Mr. Metzger's servant from going to the Hospital Dispensary. Again, yesterday, a deliberate attack was made on a Jew who was robbed & beaten, because he was carrying Kosher meat which they declared was for the Hospital patients, this meat was purchased & paid for in the usual way.

Further, only this morning there was a scrimmage between one of these Jewish patrols, & a Jewish patient who was coming to the Hospital.

Such illegal acts are not only disgraceful, but a menace to the peace
of
