His Excellency has been thus decorated on account of services rendered to Russian pilgrims, during the early part of last Spring, when several of them perished in a snow-storm between Jerusalem and Nazareth. The aid which His Excellency caused to be given on that occasion to the rest of the pilgrims, who were in great distress and enduring much suffering

suffering from the severity of the weather, has now been recognized by the Russian Government, and he has been rewarded by the presentation of the above mentioned Order.
