of His Imperial Majesty the Sultan.

His Excellency adds that a delegate  
from the Educational Board will be  
present at the Examination in Turkish,  
and he concludes by requesting me to  
take steps for the appointment, within  
one month, of suitable teachers in all  
the schools under the jurisdiction of  
this Consulate.

As I am without instructions  
on this subject, I merely acknowledged  
the receipt of the Pasha's letter - of  
which I enclose translation and copy -  
pointing

pointing out that I could take no  
action in the matter unless authorized  
by Your Excellency to do so, and I  
now have the honour to beg that I  
may be furnished with instructions as  
to further procedure.
