Sir

I have the honour to report that  
in consequence of the rupture between Russia  
and Turkey, the Consul of the former Power  
in this city left yesterday for Jaffa, to  
embark for Europe, with all the Russian  
pilgrims who were staying here, the members  
of the Russian Ecclesiastical Mission and  
some of the Russian resident subjects are  
to follow shortly. The Superintendent  
of the Russian National Establishments, who is  
at the same time Councillor of the Consulate,  
is, however, to remain, in what is described  
as a private capacity - an arrangement

which seems unusual.

On the 25<sup>th</sup> instant the Russian Consulate and National Establishments at Jerusalem, together with Russian subjects and interests, were transferred to the German Consul, under whose protection they are now placed. The transfer was effected at the Russian Consulate, whither Baron Münchhausen had repaired; the Russian flag was hoisted and lowered three times, after which the German flag was hoisted and now daily floats over the Russian Consulate, which has the effect of provoking angry comment from the Moslem population; otherwise these have remained quiet.

The Turkish Authorities however, are taking precautions to preserve order,

more especially in respect of Russian subjects and property.

I had occasion to see the Governor a day after the transfer above reported, and he informed me that he had not yet received any instructions on the subject.

I have the honor to report the arrival of a Latin Patriarch in Jerusalem, on Monday the 17<sup>th</sup> Instant with great demonstrations of honor.

The French and Sardinian Consuls rode out in full uniform to meet him - and in the train were the French and Sardinian Vice Consuls from Jaffa - The Pasha sent as a Deputation, his Dragoman, the Revenue Collector, and the Chief of the Police.

When within the City, his Clergy and the monks met the Patriarch in vestments and with lighted tapers opposite the door of the Latin Hospice, where he also
