My Lord

I have the honor to inform
Your Lordship that on the 14th
Instant, arrived in this city, a
certain *Agha* Bek of high rank,
popularly said to be charged with
superintending the repair of the
Church of the Holy Sepulchre in the
name of the Sultan.

Agha Bek was met at a
considerable distance from the city
by the Greek and Armenian Patriarchs

in person, and nears the city by
Hafiz Pasha and the Effendis

His Firman has not yet been
publicly read.

I had an interview with the
Bek on the 16th, when he particularly
expressed himself desirous of kindly
advice and information from myself,
and behaved with extreme civility.

Mr Botta, the French Consul; and
Mr Basily the Russian Consul General
are expected here on Monday next
the 20th.

Atif Bek is returning to Constantinople
from a special mission in Egypt.
