

Decypher Consul Dickson: Jerusalem. D. 1st November 1898.

Yesterday the German Emperor attended service in the German Church at Bethlehem and afterwards visited the Church of the Nativity and today he was present officially with the Empress at the opening of the new German Church of the Redeemer in this city which was a brilliant function.

During the service the Church was guarded by a company of German sailors with fixed bayonets.
