from Haider Pasha a Communicati-
on, requesting me to furnish him
with a list of the Ryahs whom I
consider as under my Protection. —

I immediately furnished
His Excellency with the information,
which he required of me, which
consists in a list of five persons, who
are in my Service, as Interpreter,
Janissaries, and Domestics; — and
an elderly Native Jew, who has a
Patent of Protection from Mr Vice-
Consul Wilkinson of Rhodes, for a
service
