them with an amount  
of zeal and self-sacrifice  
worthy of high commendation,  
Spending as His Excellency  
does the greater part of  
his time on the Road  
directing and encouraging  
the workmen.

An expression of  
satisfaction on your  
part to the Pasha would  
I venture to think be  
very gratifying and  
encouraging

encouraging to His  
Excellency, who has  
received — expressions  
of commendation from  
the different foreign  
Embassies through their  
respective Consuls here.

It may be hoped  
that by next spring the  
road will be completed.  
It will then be open  
I understand, to any  
company or private  
individual

individual to establish  
a service of "diligences",  
but under what conditions  
is not yet known.
