Sir,

I have the honour to report that the parliamentary elections for this Sanjak are now concluded, and that the three following candidates have been elected, namely :

Rouhi Effendi El Khalidi,
Hafiz Bey Es Said, and
Said Effendi El Hussini.

The three new members belong to prominent Mussulman families of Jerusalem; Rouhi Effendi, who heads the list, has been for some years Ottoman Consul-General

at Bordeause, and is said to be
a gentleman of ability and
culture; the other two are also
well spoken of. It may perhaps
be matter for regret that none
but Mussulmans have been chosen,
but the few Christian and Jewish
candidates polled but very few
votes, and there can be no
doubt that the Ottoman population
of the Sanjak is preponderantly
Mussulman, as a very large
proportion of the Jews residing
in Palestine retain foreign
nationality.
