Buildings where Divine Service has
hitherto been performed by the British
Clergy, having become unsafe in
consequence of the damage done by the
late rains, Bishop Alexander has
caused another portion of the Society's
premises to be adapted as a Chapel.

The necessary preparations have been
made without any interference on the
part of the local Authorities, and the
Congregation are to meet there for
Public Worship on the 24th Instant.

part and parcel of the Consular

Your Excellency what steps he has
taken to secure my private interest
in this arrangement.

I have the honor to report to Your Excellency that Hyda Pacha yesterday entered upon his duties in Jerusalem as Governor of this District.

His Excellency's first measure was to arrest, and to send to Prison the five Effendis pointed out by the French Consul as having taken part in the tumult on the 29 July last.

Their names are as follow -

Fordi Effendi, Achmet Aga el Jydar, Mehmet Ali Effendi, Saffet Effendi, and Halil Effendi the Bash Natib; They went to compliment the Pacha on his arrival, when, without any delay or ceremony, or further communication with their Families, they were apprehended on the spot, and placed in charge of a strong Guard of Soldiers, and hurried out of the City in the midst of the most
