 arrived here from Damascus,
 by land, on the 22nd instant,
 and left again this morning
 for Jaffa, where he will embark

on board the Austrian steamer
for Egypt. His Highness travelled
incognito, but was received
with becoming attention and
ceremony by the Local
Authorities, and after visiting
the usual places of interest
in this city, proceeded on the
26th instant to Jericho and
the Dead Sea, whence he
returned yesterday.

I have also the honour
to report that the Duke of
Orleans, accompanied by his
sister

sister the Princess Helene,
arrived in Jerusalem from Jaffa
on the 21st instant, and returned
this morning with the Duke
of Schleswig-Holstein to
Jaffa and Egypt, after having
visited the Jordan and Dead
Sea. The Duke of Orleans
also travelled incognito.
