On the following Monday morning (the riot occurred on a Saturday) Seth Dunn came to the Consulate and demanded his son, saying he was his "guardian" and on my declining to give him up without bail, he got into a violent passion and said it was all a "cheatery" on words to a similar effect. I therefore gave him to understand that he had better leave the Office, or he would be turned out. This is the interview he alludes to in which he says he spoke with the utmost moderation!
